What was the issue to be addressed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients. The new clinics will be in-addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients.• Reduction in long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist'• Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. Education support for multiple stakeholders within primary care.
What were the results?	Between January 2024 & January 2025, 999 patients were identified to be reviewed. 815 were reviewed, and 227 were initiated onto GDMT. Pharmacists now take a lead role in Diabetes reviews. Educational upskilling has resulted in additional clinics being available.
